
## The Lap of Luxury:Pets Go Posh at Fort Worth's Spa Paws Hotel

"Although he's no longer with me, the miracle is that Dakota prompted my own diagnosis and treatment, and inspired me to create a pet wellness and care center that embraces Eastern medicine."
